



## Sustainable Forest Management Policy

Canadian Kraft Paper and Nisokapawino Forestry Management Corporation commits to ensuring our forest management operations are compliant with Sustainable Forest Management (SFM) standards by:

- Achieving, implementing and maintaining SFM and PEFC Chain of Custody certifications;
- Meeting or exceeding all relevant legislation, regulations, policies, and other requirements to which the Organization subscribes;
- Providing for public participation;
- Respecting and recognizing Aboriginal title and rights, and treaty rights;
- Providing participation opportunities for Aboriginal Peoples with rights to and interests in SFM within the Defined Forest Area (DFA);
- Providing conditions and safeguards for the health and safety of DFA-related workers and the public;
- Honoring all international agreements and conventions relevant to SFM to which Canada is signatory;
- Improving knowledge about the forest and SFM, monitoring advances in SFM science and technology, and incorporating these advances where applicable; and
- Demonstrating continual improvement of SFM.
